Pupils will describe the movement of the Moon, Sun and the Earth. They will explain night and day by explaining how the Sun changes its position over the course of the day.







R.E./P.S.H.E:


-This half term we will focus on the themes of 'being loyal' and 'being hopeful'. We will also be exploring the season of Christmas.
