

Science



Home Learning

English

In reading we will be looking at the 'Man on the Moon' book and we will be understanding and talking about what we read. We will also be focusing on discussing new word meanings and linking the meaning to words we already know. We will be answering questions about what we have read and in particular looking at 'where' questions.

In writing we will be using our knowledge from History and Reading and develop our writing skills for instructions. We'll be learning to include subject specific language in our writing such as outer space. We will also be writing our own journey stories based on 'A day in the life of Bob.' We will also be writing our own information text based on knowledge learnt about Tim Peake and Neil Armstrong.

Mathematics

This term year 1 will focus on:



- Length, and heights (long/short longer/shorter)
- Mass/weight (heavy/light heavier than/lighter than)
- Capacity and volume (full/empty more than/less than)
- Fractions (recognising half as one of two equal parts and a quarter as one of four parts)
- Shape (recognising 2D and 3D shapes)

Art & DT

In DT we will be learning to design and make space buggies using our DT skills of making mechanisms. In art we will be studying the work of Paul Klee and developing our art techniques in using shapes, form and space.

R.E. / PHSE

In R.E we'll be learning about making choices. We will understand how to decide between a good and bad choice. It will include considering the outcomes of bad choices. As well as understanding what it means to be fair.

History/Geography

The children will be exploring lives of significant individuals from the past: Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake. They will learn about the importance of the journey to the moon.
