Parental code of conduct during COVID-19. Autumn Term.

PARENTS AND CARERS – COMMUNICATING WITH SCHOOL AND EXPECTATIONS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS:

- There will be no access for vehicles at any time.
- The school office remains closed but school is contactable via enquiry@birchfld.bham.sch.uk or 01214645661 for enquiries.
- Please drop off and collect your child at the allocated time and follow instructions on all signage and from staff.
- Please ensure you are prompt and on time in both dropping off and collecting your child each day.
- You MUST provide 2 working emergency contact numbers.
- We request that, as far as possible, <u>one</u> <u>family member only</u> brings and collects the children.
- Please adhere to social distancing at all times when dropping off and collecting your child.
- Parents must wear a mask/face covering when entering the school premises and whilst on site unless they are exempt on medical grounds.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD INTO SCHOOL IF THEY, OR ANYONE LIVING IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD, IS DISPLAYING ANY SYMPTOMS ASSOCIATED WITH COVID-19.

High temperature New and persistent cough Loss of, or change in your normal sense of smell/taste.

- Please inform school of this by emailing enquiry@birchfld.bham.sch.uk or via the office on 01214645661.
- If your child or a member of your household has any of the COVID-19 symptoms, they need to have a test. You must inform school of the outcome of any tests.
- Your child must not return to school until they have had a negative test result **OR** they have completed 14 days isolation.
- If your child becomes unwell at school with any of the COVID-19 symptoms, they and their siblings, must be collected immediately.
- Mrs Ahmed is the school pastoral leader and your point of contact for attendance matters.
