PARENTS AND CARERS – COMMUNICATING WITH SCHOOL AND EXPECTATIONS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS:

- *There will be no access for vehicles at any time.*
- *The school office remains closed but school is contactable via enquiry@birchfld.bham.sch.uk or 01214645661 for enquiries.*
- *Please drop off and collect your child at the allocated time and follow instructions on all signage and from staff.*
- *Please ensure you are prompt and on time in both dropping off and collecting your child each day.*
- *You MUST provide 2 working emergency contact numbers.*
- *We request that, as far as possible, one family member only brings and collects the children.*
- *Please adhere to social distancing at all times when dropping off and collecting your child.*
- *Parents must wear a mask/face covering when entering the school premises and whilst on site unless they are exempt on medical grounds.*

PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD INTO SCHOOL IF THEY, OR ANYONE LIVING IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD, IS DISPLAYING ANY SYMPTOMS ASSOCIATED WITH COVID-19.

Loss of, or change in your normal sense of smell/taste.

- *Please inform school of this by emailing enquiry@birchfld.bham.sch.uk or via the office on 01214645661.*
- *If your child or a member of your household has any of the COVID-19 symptoms, they need to have a test. **You must inform school of the outcome of any tests.***
- *Your child must not return to school until they have had a negative test result **OR** they have completed 14 days isolation.*
- *If your child becomes unwell at school with any of the COVID-19 symptoms, they and their siblings, must be collected immediately.*
- *Mrs Ahmed is the school pastoral leader and your point of contact for attendance matters.*

WE UNDERSTAND THAT YOU, AND YOUR CHILD, MAY BE FEELING ANXIOUS ABOUT COMING TO SCHOOL AT THIS TIME.

- *We will do all that we can to support them emotionally with the differences they will notice in school.*
