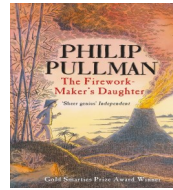

Our new class text is *The Firework Maker's Daughter* and our focus will be following the plot of the story. In depth studies of the main characters, retrieval of information and finding the meaning of new and unknown vocabulary in context and making inferences.

Using the text children will be focussing on writing to entertain the reader using a range of vocabulary choices and extending their sentences. Their focus will be to write an informal letter, identifying the language and organisational features independently.

History/ Geography:



In Geography, we will be looking at the layers of the Earth and exploring different types of volcanoes and their features. Alongside this we will be exploring the concept of an eruption and what takes place under the ground to cause these. In **History**, the children will be researching Vishal Verma (fossil hunter) who discovered dinosaur eggs and a fossil called Cidaris.
