

## Mathematics

This term year 1 will focus on place value and addition and subtraction within 10.

- Count, read and write forward and backwards from any number 0-10.
- Number bonds to 10
- Counting forwards and backwards
- Finding more and less than a given number
- Adding two amounts together
- Subtracting one amount from another



## Art/DT/Music

In Art the children will be developing a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

In DT the children will be using a range of media, tools and techniques to create images, express ideas and show different emotions

This term the children will be learning to sing and perform the song "Hey You!".



## R.E./ PSHE

In R.E, we'll be learning about belonging. We will discuss how we can belong to different communities, religions, clubs and families. We will look at how belonging make us feel and why is it so important to feel like you belong.

In PSHE, we will be exploring 'What makes a good friend?'

The children will be researching about houses from the past and how they have changed over time. We will be exploring the Victorian Era and the Tudor Era to understand how homes were built then and how they have changed. They will also be learning about what a family tree is and comparing how life was different in the 1950's to today.
