Communication and Language	We encourage the children to listen to stories and recall parts of a story (What is happening at the beginning, middle, end of the story?).
	The children will learn new vocabulary through a range of fiction and non-fiction books.
Expressive Arts and Design	Joining in with songs and rhymes.
	Colour recognition (Learning colour names).
	Mood paintings (Happy, sad)
	Leaf paintings, using leaves and different coloured paints.
Understanding of the World	Making small world models.
	Discussing different home experiences
	and celebrations (Diwali/Christmas).
	Visit to the local allotment.

	Making gingerbread men.
	Talking about our family members.
Physical Development	Kick/catch a large ball.
	Negotiating space in the outdoor environment.
	Begin to show preference for a dominant hand.
	Join in with games (Musical statues).
