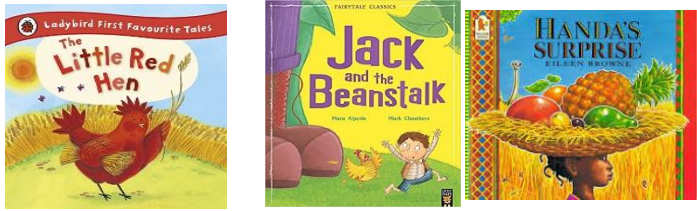

Enquiry Question	What do we need to make plants grow? Ready, Steady, Grow (Signs of Spring)
Class Texts	Jack and the beanstalk, The Little Red Hen, Handa's Surprise 
Literacy	Writing instructions for how to plant seeds Reading and writing shopping lists Writing instructions for how to make bread Looking at different recipe books and food labels Writing a recipe for making a fruit salad Recognise some tricky and high frequency words Writing words and sentences linked to

	different environments
Maths	Learning about number bonds ($1+4 = 5$, $2 +3=5$) Subtraction ($10- 4= 6$) Recognising numerals 1-10 Sharing objects Subitising (Counting objects without pointing to each individual object)
Communication and Language	Listens to familiar stories and recall parts of the story Use new vocabulary throughout the day Discuss the beginning, middle and end of a story Answer how and why questions, linked to stories. How did Jack feel? Learning new rhymes, poems and songs Asking questions about the environment and plants
Expressive Arts and Design	Use movement to express feelings Using imagination to create seasonal pictures Making transport models using junk modelling materials

	Experiment with musical instruments. Design and make a farm for The Little Red Hen and a house for Jack Role play linked to the Handa's Surprise
Understanding of the World	Visit to the local mosque and learning about different occupations and celebrations Discussing different seasons and changes Drawing a map to help The Little Red Hen travel to the farm Discussing different environments and countries Exploring the natural world
PE	Experiment with different ways of moving during PE sessions (Rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, skipping) Using scissors to cut out different sized shapes Develop ball skills (Throwing, catching, kicking, passing, battling and aiming skills) Form some recognisable upper and

	lower case letters Using cutlery correctly Using scissors to cut out a shape
Key Vocabulary	Plants Grow Trees Sunny Environment Different Journey Beginning, middle, end Seed, water
