knowledge and skills we will be covering this half term.

Class Texts	Owl Babies /Goldilocks and the three bears
Literacy	The children will be learning Phase 1 phonics– Rhyming words and Action songs. Reading favourite stories. Can we talk about what is happening in the pictures? Filling in missing words from a rhyme Learning the names of different parts of a book (Front cover, back cover, pages)
Maths	Joining in with number rhymes and songs Begin to understand positional language (In, on, under) Count up to 5, using number names in order Begin to name some 2D shapes

Communication and Language	Clapping out rhymes and joining in with actions Talking about different experiences and celebrations Begin to use past and present tenses (I played with my toy) Understand 'who' questions Discussing what the children have made, using longer sentences Recall some parts of a familiar story
Expressive Arts and Design	Drawing pictures from a story Making stick hand puppets Tap out a beat to help Mr Bear fall asleep Begin to role play parts of the stories
Understanding of the World	Playing with small world models Going on an autumn walk and collecting leaves Bark and leaf rubbings Using the iPad to play a game Talking about our family members

Physical Development	Kick/catch a large ball Fruit tasting (Different textures) Turning pages correctly in a book Building with small and large blocks Developing pencil grip using a range of tools (Pencils/crayons)
